


Why Regulate PFAS?

Source of data: voluntary testing by military bases and public water systems

Timeline of Lab Rule (WAC 246-390)



Lab Rule Change Overview

Changes to the rule to include PFAS test panel and requirements

Changes to address notifications for PFAS detections and future contaminants with a SAL

Technical changes

PFAS Specific Changes

Testing methods

EPA methods 537.1 and 533 will be allowed

Reporting limits

PFAS reporting limits are 2 ng/L (except for NEtFOSAA and NMeFOSAA which are 3 ng/L).

Data reporting

Labs will report any result above established state detection reporting limits to the water system and to DOH as a detection.

Comments on Lab Rule

COMMENT:

As soon as practical, approve expanded analytical methods in PFAS testing (such as Total Organic Fluorine)

RESPONSE:

Expanded test methods aren't ready to be required in this first round of the rule but could be added as a supplemental research project, if funding is identified

COMMENT:

Ensure that records of lab testing data are kept and accessible to the public

RESPONSE:

The department intends to enter these in DOH database and make accessible to the public
